Brief Description of Activity:

This activity is centered as a Brown Bag Event. Brown Bag Events have been essential to the Duval community for several years. Geared primarily towards churches and senior health days, Brown Bag Events are run by Jacksonville Instructional Site faculty and NDPAC First Coast members and P4 PharmD learners. Learners provide participants with a brief mechanism of action and side effect profile of all medications being taken by them at the time. Learners also offer dietary and lifestyle modification therapy under the direct supervision of FAMU pharmacists. Participants also will have their blood pressure read and blood glucose measured during the time of the event.
