## 2011 – 2012 INDIVIDUAL CONTRIBUTION CAMPAIGN



### The Automatic Bank Deduction and PayPal Program

This program provides means for supporters to contribute to NDPAC's 2011-2012 Contribution Campaign through automatic withdrawals from their bank. Through this program, a contributor establishes a reasonable monthly contribution based on the desired yearly total to the campaign. An accounting of the contributions is tallied by NDPAC and reported to the membership on a quarterly basis. At the conclusion of the campaign, a large bronze plaque designating the Contributor's Levels of giving is displayed in the FAMU College of Pharmacy for all to see. The following is a sample of the withdrawal amounts at various funding levels:
